Relevant Policy Changes (May-Oct 2019):

- Removal of all countries from the designated countries of origin list
- Several changes to support people trying to leave abusive situations, including waiving the fee for people
 experiencing family violence; allowing them to obtain a temporary resident permit, health care, and work
 permit; and expediting H&C applications for these individuals.
